What to expect when

Some parents have asked about the EYFS. What it is and how we use it,
I will be including a document in the email.

The purpose of this booklet is to help you as a parent/carer* find out more about how your child is learning and developing during their first five years, in relation to the EYFS. Children develop more rapidly during the first five years of their lives than at any other time. This booklet has been written to help you as a parent know what to expect during these vitally important years by focusing on the seven areas of learning and development which are covered in the EYFS. In this guide, your child's first five years have been divided up into six age bands which overlap. This is because every child is different and children do not grow and develop at the same rate. It highlights what you might notice your child doing at these points.

As we are entering warmer months now we want to get prepared for the summer sun. We are asking that you provide a named sun cream and named sun hat asap for your child's room. Oral hygiene



We encourage the children to brush their teeth after lunch and tea, please bring a toothbrush and toothpaste into the setting. Where possible we ask that you buy a brush with a cap to protect the brush from germs. Each baby/child will have a toothbrush holder with their name on and this will be placed on a high shelf to prevent cross contamination.

Nursery Activities

Babies: -

Babies have been learning about families.

They have been bathing the dolls with bubbles and sponges, looking at our family photos!!
Songs about our families including mummy thumb! 5 little ducks.

Stories about families including I can help and korky's puppy school.

We will also be learning about Numbers.
Using our number ducks, Counting songs such as speckled frogs, 5 cheeky monkeys.

Also using our building blocks
And our magic socks!

Two to three's: -

Our theme in the twos is currently transport, they are talking about how they travel places such as how they get to nursery.

People who help us and the transport they use, such as police, the colours of the transport and the noises they make.

The twos are also getting ready for the royal wedding, with their transport theme, they will be making their own carriage as this is how the royals are travelling to the wedding!!

We are also teaching early independence and self-care, with wiping our won noses and getting our own coats and shoes and helping to zip them up and attempting to put them on ourselves!

Three to five: -

Our threes to fives will be getting ready for the royal wedding and shall be doing some amazing activities surrounding the royal family.

School readiness activities will be starting, we will be promoting independence surrounding putting on our shoes and coats.

Talking about our schools, and role playing with the uniforms and practising pencil control.

They are also exploring sensory activities and are talking about textures and making their own sensory board
