# STOP THE SPREAD OF CORONAVIRUS

We understand that you may still have concerns, and be unsure about your child who is returning or already at nursery but we have supported key worker children beginning the lockdown and have now successfully created a welcoming and safety focused environment for everyone to enjoy. The systems we have been using have been enhanced further to reflect Government guidance and we aim to provide you reassurance that protecting our staff and your children is our priority. Working together, is also important for creating a safer environment so we ask that you work with us to ensure that anyone who is unwell does not attend our nursery. We also ask that whilst you are at home and outside the nursery that you continue with your good hygiene practices, social distancing and avoid contact with any individuals showing symptoms associated with Coronavirus. If you have doubt about your health or that of your child, we would ask that you seek and follow medical advice before coming back to nursery.

For your information: Testing is now available to anyone with symptoms of coronavirus

The government has announced that anyone with symptoms of coronavirus is now eligible to book a test, including children under the age of 5 years. Anyone experiencing a new, continuous cough; high temperature; or a loss of, or change, in their normal sense of smell or taste (anosmia) can book a test. A coronavirus test can be booked here:

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# **Important Dates**

- 13th-17th July between 10-2pm only for preschool parents to collect all belongings/folders/reports for transition to schools.
- o Last day of Term Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> July for all funded children.
- Last day for all child Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> August (children who attend all year round and are transitioning to school in September.)
- o New autumn term starts Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> September.

#### August Closure

Due to demand and term finishing in July we have taken a decision to partially close down the nursery sessions in August. We had originally planned this before our opening but needed to assess the current situation and a number of other such as staff availability, childcare demand and financial sustainability.

If you attend on Mondays and Fridays please look into changing your days for the next month. We are letting you know well in advance so you can make alternative arrangements or we can accommodate you on the 3 days we are offering, Tuesday/Wednesday and Thursday, 8.30 to 5pm maximum.

September we should be running back as normal with hours, sessions and cooked meals. Will update if anything changes locally or with government guidelines. But we may change how we deliver the PM sessions for funding for the Autumn term on a temporary basis, 1-4pm over 5 days for both 2- and 3-year olds. Its still a difficult time ahead trying to get things to normal and adjusting to life style changes and guidelines in staying safe and business staying a float as well.

# Current availability

We have had lots of enquiries since reopening, about spaces and availability throughout the nursery. We are still offering parents the opportunity to come and view the nursery but this will take place in August when its much quiet, after sessions have finished for the day.

If you are a returning parent then please call or email Reena with confirming your sessions and days for availability for September term.

New planners will be given in September to you in person and you can always pick one up from the patio area. It will include all term dates, Staff/inset days/closures, Parent meetings etc.
